## Tools are guaranteed to be returned in as good or better condition!

As well as volunteers, we also need to borrow tools for the Playground build week. We guarantee that your tools will be returned in as good or better condition as we received them, or we will replace them. That's a promise! We have funds set aside for tool replacement and repair and we will be using our own drill/router bits and saw blades. In addition, we have arranged for 24-hour security on our tool trailer. We ask that you label your tools, and we will have a labeling system as well. Many volunteers have said that they plan to bring their tools with them when they come to work, but please be aware that we need the following list of tools to be in our trailer for the span of the job to avoid being caught short a tool or two at any point in the project. Even if you plan to volunteer, please consider checking your tools into the trailer for the duration of the project.

All tools will be identified as to ownership. Tools will be locked up when not in use.
